Eligibility- Artists residing in Northern NM within the area of Santa Fe, Taos, Farmington, and including Bayfield and Alamosa CO, are eligible to apply. Some artists from beyond this area are eligible by invitation.

Jury- New artists' work will be reviewed by a jury for inclusion in the art festival and studio tour. Please send images promptly after submitting the application.

Entry Procedure- If you are not able to complete the application online, download the application on our website chamavalleyartsfest.org, call (505) 492-3339 or email info@chamavalleyarts.org and we can email or mail you a copy.

Fees- Artist registration fee: \$50 ~Art festival booths: *10 x 10 space \$25, 10 x 20 space \$50*. Every artist exhibiting and selling work must complete an application.

Booths- Artists provide all of their own equipment for booths, including displays, tables, chairs, and canopies if needed.

Booth Locations- Studio Tour artists may show from their own home and studio or location of their choice. They may choose to put a booth at the festival grounds in Chama or in several locations along Terrace Avenue in the village. Artists setting up booths within the Village of Chama Festival Area will be assigned a space and will be contacted to confirm their booth placement.

Liability- The *CVAF* will not be responsible for damage to, loss, or theft of artwork, display materials, or personal belongings. Nor can *CVAF* be held liable for acts of terrorism or individuals committing illegal acts during the Art Festival.

Taxes- Festival artists are responsible to purchase a Village of Chama business license to be displayed at your booth **if you pay sales tax**. The cost is \$35. Village of Chama Gross Receipts Tax rate: 8.31%.

Publicity- All applicants are encouraged to send brief biographical materials and photos to be used on social media and our website. *CVAF* reserves the right to use any photos or written materials for promotional purposes. Festival information is shared with media outlets throughout Northern and Central New Mexico, Southern Colorado, the Four Corners, West Texas, social media, and on posters and banners throughout the region.

Photo/Video Release- Submission of this application gives *CVAF* permission to use your image and video or audio recordings of you taken during the festival, for promotional purposes.

Donation to Auction- *CVAF* requests that every artist donate an artwork (minimum value \$15) to the auction in support of *CVAF*. Please send an image, description, and value of the piece for the auction at the time of your application.

Please Read Carefully

- New artists to the ***Chama Art Festival and Studio Tour*** will be subject to approval by a jury. Your work will be reviewed by a panel for inclusion.
- Digital images of your work are preferred. They will be used for the selection process and may be used in advertising. Only images submitted digitally will be used for advertising.
- Only artwork which has been represented on your application may be displayed at the festival.
- All work must be created and produced by the exhibitor.
- Resale of commercially manufactured goods is not permitted.
- Jewelers are permitted to sell finished work only. Pre-made materials (beads, charms, etc.) cannot be sold separately; they must be incorporated into the artist's own completed designs.
- It is prohibited to display political or religious handouts or brochures
- The ***Chama Valley Art Festival and Studio Tour*** reserves the right to reject any exhibitor who does not abide by this agreement.

Deadlines and Cancellations

Artists who apply by April 15th will have an image of their work included in the brochure. Application window closes 7/31/2025. After all booth spaces are filled applicants will be placed on a waiting list. Applicants on the waiting list may be asked to join if other exhibitors cancel. Cancellations made at least two weeks prior to the event will be refunded, except \$15 admin fee. No refunds will be issued after August 16th. No refunds will be issued due to weather. If an artist does not cancel and does not show up, they will not be considered for inclusion in CVAF 2026.

Submission Media- Applicants must submit 3 to 5 digital images as samples of their work to info@chamavalleyarts.org. If unable to send digital images, you may send photos or a USB drive to Chama Valley Arts P.O. Box 95, Chama NM 87520.
